

Medical Enrollment Forms

Listed by Grade:

ALL STUDENTS:

[Online Family Demographics and Health Forms](#) – all parents must go online to ParentsWeb and complete these forms preferably by August 1st, but no later than the first day of school. These forms are found on the ParentsWeb under Web Forms. Click on “Family Demographics Form.” If you need help setting up an account, [please view the FACTS \(RenWeb\) tutorial](#). Please note this is required in order to receive progress & report cards.

[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#) - required for preschool, junior and senior kindergarten (must be done after the age of 4), sixth (6) grade, and ninth (9) grade students and new incoming students grades PS to 12 and submitted by the first day of school. ALL students must have this on file and will be required to get one if they do not have the most up-to-date physical exam form on file. All physical exams shall be signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine in all of its branches, an advanced practice nurse who has a written collaborative agreement with a collaborating physician that authorizes him/her to perform health examinations, or a physician assistant to whom has been delegated the performance of health examinations by his/her supervising physician. (Section 27-8.1(2) of the School Code) A physician is required to review and sign any portion of the Certificate of Child Health Examination completed by a registered nurse who is not an advanced practice nurse.

ALL FORMS ARE DUE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

ALL SENIORS (12th grade):

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

[Meningococcal Vaccination Documentation](#) (our form or the doctor’s form – must be signed by the doctor). This requirement is for grade 12. All students entering grade 12 must show proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine. If the first dose of MCV4 was administered after 16 years of age, then only 1 dose of MCV4 is required at entrance to grade 12. Our form: [Documentation of MCV4 Administration](#)

NEW STUDENTS GRADES 10-12:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

[Physical Exam form](#) from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the 9th grade physical. *Sports physicals are not acceptable in place of the Certificate of Child Health Examination.*

ALL 9TH GRADE:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

Physical Exam form from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record. **Sports physicals are not acceptable in place of the Certificate of Child Health Examination.*

9th Grade Dental Exam – As of 2019-2020, all 9th grade students are required to have a new Dental Exam.

STUDENT ATHLETES GRADES 9-12:

[IHSA Pre-Participation Examination](#) and [IHSA Concussion Information and Sports Medicine Acknowledgement & Consent Form](#) due the first day of practice. Done yearly.

NEW STUDENTS GRADES 7-8:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

[Online Family Demographics and Health Forms](#) – all parents must go online to ParentsWeb and complete these forms by the first day of school.

Physical Exam form from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record. Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the 6th grade physical exam. **Sports physicals are not acceptable in place of the Certificate of Child Health Examination.* Tdap & Meningococcal Vaccination given at the 6th grade physical examination and documented on the physical exam.

Dental Exam. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the 6th grade dental exam.*

Eye Exam by an eye doctor, not your pediatrician. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the Kindergarten eye exam.*

ALL 6TH GRADE:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

Physical Exam form from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record. **Sports physicals are not acceptable in place of the Certificate of Child Health Examination.*

Tdap & Meningococcal Vaccinations are given at the 6th grade physical examination and must be documented on the physical exam.

Tdap Vaccine: Illinois Department of Public Health rules adopted in September 2011 now mandate that all students currently enrolled in grades six through twelve, shall show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccine regardless of the interval since the last Dtap, DT or Td dose.
Meningococcal Vaccine: All students entering grade 6 must show proof of receiving one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4) on or after 11 years of age.

6th Grade Dental Exam. Must be a new exam done within a year of the start of 6th grade.

STUDENT ATHLETES GRADES 5-8:

Sports Physical Exam form due the first day of practice. Done yearly. Can be on the [Certificate of Child Health Examination](#) or the [IHSA Pre-Participation Exam](#).

NEW STUDENTS GRADES 3-5:

Health Emergency Form 2019-2020 required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

Online Family Demographics and Health Forms – all parents must go online to ParentsWeb and complete these forms by the first day of school.

Physical Exam form from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the Kindergarten grade physical exam.*

Dental Exam. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the 2nd grade dental exam.*

Eye Exam by an eye doctor, not your pediatrician. *Note, you may submit a copy of the last required state exam which would be the Kindergarten eye exam.*

[Physical Exam form](#) from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record done at age 5.

New [Eye Exam](#) by an eye doctor, not your pediatrician.

JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

[Online Family Demographics and Health Forms](#) – all parents must go online to ParentsWeb and complete these forms by the first day of school.

[Physical Exam form](#) from the State of Illinois called the “[Certificate of Child Health Examination](#)” with complete immunization record done after the age of 4.

PRESCHOOL:

[Health Emergency Form 2019-2020](#) required for ALL STUDENTS from preschool through grade 12 by the first day of school.

FORMS FOR STUDENTS WITH MEDICAL CONDITIONS

STUDENTS WITH EPIPEN/SEVERE FOOD ALLERGIES:

[Anaphylaxis-Emergency-Action-Plan](#) with medication orders if child is carrying an EpiPen & if the nurse needs to give Benadryl orally.

STUDENTS WITH ASTHMA:

[Asthma Action Plan](#) with medication orders if the student carries an inhaler and/or nurse gives medication.

STUDENTS WITH ADD OR ADHD:

[ADD-ADHD Care Plan](#) with medication orders if nurse is giving medication at school.

STUDENTS WITH DIABETES, SEIZURES, CONCUSSIONS, OR OTHER MEDICAL PROBLEMS:

[Diabetes Medical Management Plan](#), [Seizure Action Plan](#), [Concussion Care Plan](#), [Individual Care Plan](#) (for other conditions not mentioned) all with medication orders as needed.

RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION FORM:

PLEASE NOTE: We do not force anyone to have immunizations that they object to. We believe that the health of the child is the responsibility of the parent. You may submit a religious exemption: the [State of Illinois Certificate of Religious Exemption to Required Immunizations](#) form.

ALL MEDICATION GIVEN AT SCHOOL:

We must have a doctor's order for all medication given at school, including over-the-counter medications. Orders may be included on the care plans as listed above or on the [Medication Authorization](#).
